## **Work ONLINE via Blackboard Collaborate**

Real time, virtual immediate feedback

Connect with a writing tutor in real-time via Blackboard Collaborate. Ask questions, share your writing assignments, and receive feedback through a one-on-one tutoring session with a tutor. Make sure you have this information: Student ID#, Class, Instructor name, and Information about the assignment.

\*\*To get credit you need to, provide a <u>screenshot</u> of work with the tutor online—IT SHOULD SHOW YOUR WORK —have the chat or participant screen open so it shows you and the tutor there as well.

If you don't show you've worked on the assignment by showing the assignment in the context of the writing center Blackboard page, you will not get credit. You also will not get credit if you only send the email confirmation they sent you.\*\*
