

INRW Portfolio

Final Portfolio (25% of total grade)

Your portfolio will be submitted in print at the end of the semester in a folder or small binder. It should include the following and be arranged in this order:

- A. Portfolio Introduction letter (25%):** Your portfolio should begin with a cover letter for the portfolio in which you discuss what you've learned about writing in general over the course of the semester and what things you need to do to help yourself do a good job with it and what things you need to avoid in order to do better.

- B. Final Reflection Essay (25%):** During our final, you will write one further work for this course reflecting on your writing. We will discuss it during the last two weeks of classes.

- C. Essays and Cover Letters (25%):** These are your essays and cover letters done in English 1301, as well as your post-conference reflections.
 - Arrange them this way:
 - Emblematic Essay
 - Cover letter— final draft with other versions behind that
 - Essay— final draft with other versions behind that
 - Literary Essay
 - Cover letter—final draft with other versions behind that
 - Essay— final draft with other versions behind that

- D. Summary/Responses (25%):** Include all summary/responses done in class, **placing the ones you want final grades for on the top**. Include all drafts you've done with each summary/response.
